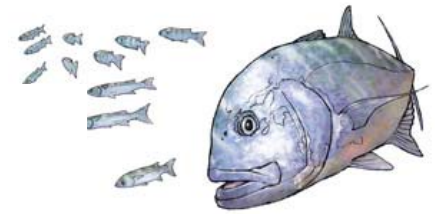


Mackay Coasts and Communities
