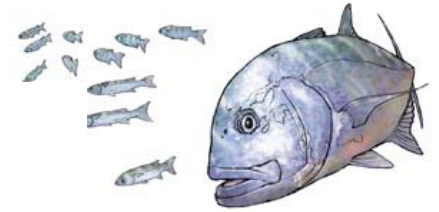
Get involved... at your beach
