

## Waste Services Performance Management Report July 2011

### Management

- Hogan's Pocket Landfill - Cell 2 Construction
  - Construction of cell 2 continues to progress. The majority of the work has been completed for the two new sediment dams. The original sediment dam has now been decommissioned and work is now focussed on the construction of cell floor and walls. Construction of the new leachate dam has been slow due to the large amount of rock being encountered. The contractor will now be blasting the rock to achieve design.
- Pioneer Valley – Kerbside Waste and Recycling Collection
  - Pioneer Valley Change Day of Service Project commenced for 620 properties in the Pioneer Valley. Most changes are from Monday to Friday and Thursday to Friday. Letters were hand delivered to each affected property and a sticker attached to each bin presented the week before the change. The Change Day of Service will commence as of week starting 1 August 2011.

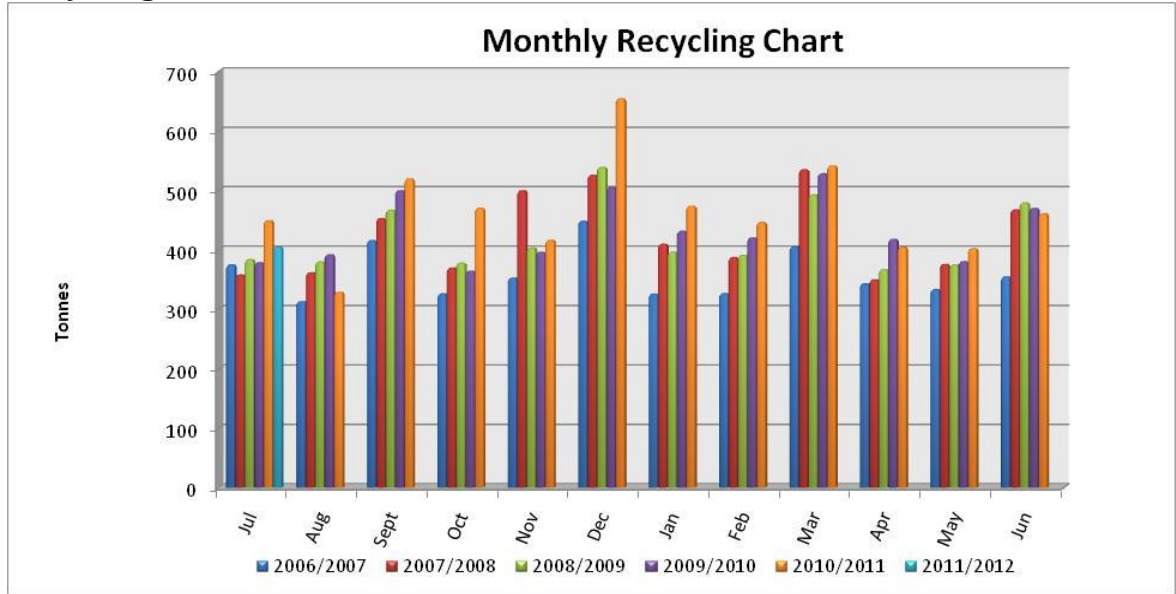

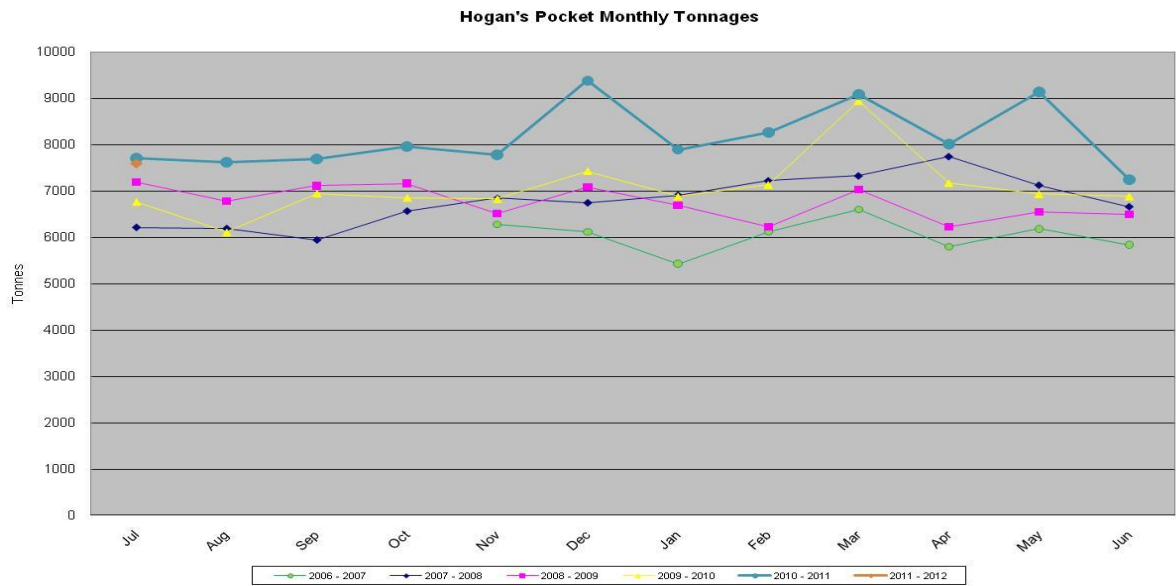
